## SEMINAR: BRANDON LAGAERT IN *MOEDER* – ANALYSIS OF MY STAGE PERSONA



In this 2-hour seminar, Brandon Lagaert will break down his character from *Moeder* and discuss how the material was developed.

- Where did the movements originate from?
- What was the inspiration for his mannerisms/look?
- How did the text evolve?

These questions will be answered along unseen footage from the creation and excerpts from the performance.

At the end of the presentation there will be a short Q&A where the participants can ask questions about the creation process or other elements connected to the work of Peeping Tom.

### **WORKSHOP SERIES: YI-CHUN LIU – EXPLORING VIRTUAL SPACES**



Technological devices have become an important part of our lives due to COVID-19 and social distancing has allowed us to spend much more time alone. This means that the space we inhabit has become the dominant area in our lives.

This space is sometimes messy, and sometimes wild.

In Yi-chun Liu's workshop series, you will virtually explore these personal spaces. Yi-chun will nourish your imagination and help you find ways to express it physically. Together you will explore the bodies you inhabit, and by working with your individual spaces, create scenes, situations, and mini performance episodes to share with each other.

The workshop series is made up of thematically linked units of 3 days per week. Participants can choose to do only one 3-day unit, or follow the progress over the course of several weeks. Participants have to be available for all 3 days to enroll in a workshop unit.

- 02/07- 04/07 \*Building a character inspired by nature
- 09/07-11/07 \*Objects in our daily life

\*Based on this schedule, the weekly workshop series could be continued to explore different topics.

The participants are invited to document their daily explorations in a 1-5-minute clip and share it in a closed social-media group as an exercise. At the end of each week, on Sundays, we will do an Open Chat to share our thoughts and close the workshop.

#### Practical:

Participants have to be available for all three days. This workshop is designed for dancers who are exploring theatrical elements and/or physical performers who focus in their work on movement and transformation in performance.

# WORKSHOP: MARIA CAROLINA VIEIRA – ROOM INVESTIGATION HOW TO CREATE A DANCE THEATRE SCENE IN YOUR OWN HOUSE THROUGH VIDEO



There are infinite characters, situations and dance moves hidden at your place! Let's look under your bed, behind the sofa, across some doors and find out together where they are! In this workshop, Maria Carolina Vieira will share with you some tools to create images and action, investigating the relation between a defined-space and the body. Every participant will find a frame into their own space (bedroom, living, bathroom, garden, or even a wardrobe or a bathtub) as a scenario/set to create a scene.

Every morning the participants will have 1h30 of live content with Maria Carolina in Zoom. She will work with concepts and tasks, exposing the use of the space as a starting point to create images, movement, characters and scenes. Pictures and videos of Peeping Tom performances and her personal work will be used to support and guide those concepts and tasks. **The participants/performers will investigate the tasks during the live session but also after, having "homework" to be explored and shared with the group.** Every evening all the participants will gather again for an hour of feedback and a round of questions and answers as a way to develop the materials and deepen the artistic investigation.

#### Practical:

Participants have to be available for all three days of a session. This workshop is designed for professional dancers or for actors with experience in movement. You should also be open to participate in a WhatsApp group.
